Lent Is Near Here are the Holy Rosary Plans to Begin the Season

- We will have Holy Thursday Services at Holy Rosary, likely at 5PM with washing of the feet.

Ash Wednesday & Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence

Those over 14 abstain on Ash Wednesday & all Fridays in Lent by not eating meat.

Fast if you are 18-59 or as health allows. No snacks, 1 regular meal & 2 small ones.
