Additional Thoughts from Saint Teresa of Calcutta:

"Humility is the mother of all virtues; purity, charity and obedience. It is in being humble that our love becomes real, devoted and ardent. If you are humble nothing will touch you, neither praise nor disgrace, because you know what you are. If you are blamed you will not be discouraged. If they call you a saint you will not put yourself on a pedestal.

Mon 10/28 Feast of Saints Simon and Jude

Jude was really Judas too but in Luke this makes it easier to keep him separate from Iscariot. In Matthew and Mark, they call him Thaddeus instead. We know he traveled to Mesopotamia to preach but we are not totally sure he wrote *The letter of Jude*. Simon is spoken of in all four Gospels. To separate him from "Peter, he was identified as the Zealot. He went to Egypt. Like Jude, we do not know much else except that their work brought both of them together again in what is now Iran; here they were both martyred. (St. Jude is the saint of hopeless causes.)
